- 1 AN ACT Relating to public art and educational displays; and
- 2 amending RCW 43.17.200.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.17.200 and 1983 c 204 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, all state
- 7 agencies including all state departments, boards, councils,
- 8 commissions, and quasi public corporations shall allocate, as a
- 9 nondeductible item, out of any moneys appropriated for the original
- 10 construction of any public building, an amount of one-half of one
- 11 percent of the appropriation to be expended by the Washington state
- 12 arts commission for the acquisition of works of art. The works of art
- 13 may be placed on public lands, integral to or attached to a public
- 14 building or structure, detached within or outside a public building or
- 15 structure, part of a portable exhibition or collection, part of a
- 16 temporary exhibition, or loaned or exhibited in other public
- 17 facilities. In addition to the cost of the works of art the one-half
- 18 of one percent of the appropriation as provided herein shall be used to

- 1 Washington state arts commission and all costs for installation of the

- 3 include highway construction sheds, warehouses or other buildings of a

- 5 (2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to the
- 6 construction of any building, structure, or facility under the control
- 7 of the department of corrections.
