- 1 AN ACT Relating to higher education tuition; and amending RCW
- 2 28B.15.067.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.067 and 1996 c 212 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Tuition fees shall be established under the provisions of this 7 chapter.
- 8 (2) Academic year tuition for full-time students at the state's 9 institutions of higher education for the 1995-96 academic year, other 10 than the summer term, shall be as provided in this subsection.
- 11 (a) At the University of Washington and Washington State 12 University:
- (i) For resident undergraduate students and other resident students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, two thousand seven hundred sixty-four dollars;
- (ii) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresident students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and

- (iii) For resident graduate students, three thousand four hundred forty-three dollars; and
- 26 (iv) For nonresident graduate students, eleven thousand seventy-one dollars.

- 3 (4) The tuition fees established under this chapter shall not apply 4 to high school students enrolling in community colleges under RCW 5 28A.600.300 through 28A.600.395.
- 6 (5) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresident
  7 students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading
  8 to the degrees of doctor of medicine or doctor of dental surgery at the
  9 University of Washington, tuition fees shall be ten thousand two
  10 hundred seventy-eight dollars in the 1997-98 academic year and eleven
  11 thousand one hundred thirty dollars in the 1998-99 academic year.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
