- 1 AN ACT Relating to commercial salmon fishery licenses; and amending
- 2 RCW 75.28.110 and 75.28.095.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 75.28.110 and 1996 c 267 s 28 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The following commercial salmon fishery licenses are required 7 for the license holder to use the specified gear to fish for salmon in 8 state waters. Only a person who meets the qualifications of RCW 9 75.30.120 may hold a license listed in this subsection. The licenses 10 and their annual fees and surcharges under RCW 75.50.100 are:

- 3 (2) A license issued under this section authorizes no taking or 4 delivery of salmon or other food fish unless a vessel is designated 5 under RCW 75.28.045.
- 6 (3) Holders of commercial salmon fishery licenses may retain 7 incidentally caught food fish other than salmon, subject to rules of 8 the department.
 - (4) A salmon troll license includes a salmon delivery license.
- 10 (5) A salmon gill net license authorizes the taking of salmon only 11 in the geographical area for which the license is issued. The 12 geographical designations in subsection (1) of this section have the 13 following meanings:
- (a) "Puget Sound" includes waters of the Strait of Juan de Fuca,
 Georgia Strait, Puget Sound and all bays, inlets, canals, coves,
 sounds, and estuaries lying easterly and southerly of the international
 boundary line and a line at the entrance to the Strait of Juan de Fuca
 projected northerly from Cape Flattery to the lighthouse on Tatoosh
 Island and then to Bonilla Point on Vancouver Island.
- (b) "Grays Harbor-Columbia river" includes waters of Grays Harbor and tributary estuaries lying easterly of a line projected northerly from Point Chehalis Light to Point Brown and those waters of the Columbia river and tributary sloughs and estuaries easterly of a line at the entrance to the Columbia river projected southerly from the most westerly point of the North jetty to the most westerly point of the South jetty.
 - (c) "Willapa Bay-Columbia river" includes waters of Willapa Bay and tributary estuaries and easterly of a line projected northerly from Leadbetter Point to the Cape Shoalwater tower and those waters of the Columbia river and tributary sloughs described in (b) of this subsection.
- 32 (6) A commercial salmon fishery license may be renewed under this 33 section if the license holder notifies the department by May 1st of 34 that year that he or she will not participate in the fishery during 35 that calendar year. The license holder shall pay the one hundred-36 dollar enhancement surcharge plus a fifteen-dollar handling charge to 37 be considered a valid renewal and eligible to participate in the 38 following year.

- (2) Except as provided in subsection (5) of this section, it is unlawful to operate a vessel as a charter boat from which salmon or salmon and other food fish or shellfish are taken without a salmon charter license designating the vessel. The director may issue a 19 salmon charter license only to a person who meets the qualifications of RCW 75.30.065.
- 21 (3) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (5) of this section, 22 it is unlawful to operate a vessel as a charter boat from which food 23 fish or shellfish are taken without a nonsalmon charter license. As used in this subsection, "food fish" does not include salmon. 24
 - (4) "Charter boat" means a vessel from which persons may, for a fee, fish for food fish or shellfish for personal use, and that brings food fish or shellfish into state ports or brings food fish or shellfish taken from state waters into United States ports. director may specify by rule when a vessel is a "charter boat" within this definition. "Charter boat" does not mean a vessel used by a guide for clients fishing for food fish for personal use in freshwater rivers, streams, and lakes, other than Lake Washington or that part of the Columbia River below the bridge at Longview.
 - (5) A charter boat licensed in Oregon may fish without a Washington charter license under the same rules as Washington charter boat operators in ocean waters within the jurisdiction of Washington state from the southern border of the state of Washington to Leadbetter Point, as long as the Oregon vessel does not land at any Washington port with the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers.
