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## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1572

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- 1 AN ACT Relating to quieting title; and amending RCW 7.28.090.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 7.28.090 and 1977 ex.s. c 80 s 7 are each amended to 4 read as follows:
- 5 <u>(1) Neither RCW 7.28.070 ((and)), 7.28.080, nor common law adverse</u>
- 6 possession shall ((not)) extend to lands or tenements owned by the
- 7 United States or this state, nor to school lands, nor to lands held for
- 8 any public purpose. Nor shall ((they)) RCW 7.28.070 and 7.28.080
- 9 extend to lands or tenements when there shall be an adverse title to
- 10 such lands or tenements, and the holder of such adverse title is a
- 11 person under eighteen years of age, or incompetent within the meaning
- 13 incompetent persons and persons under eighteen years of age who hold

of RCW 11.88.010((\* PROVIDED, Such persons as aforesaid)). However,

- 14 <u>adverse title to lands or tenements</u> shall commence an action to recover
- 15 such lands or tenements ((so possessed as aforesaid,)) within three
- 16 years after the several disabilities ((herein enumerated shall)) cease
- 17 to exist((-, -)) and shall prosecute such action to judgment((-, -)). In
- 18 the case of vacant and unoccupied land, incompetent persons and persons
- 19 under eighteen years of age shall, within ((the time last aforesaid,

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pay to the person or persons who have paid the same for his or her betterments, and the taxes, with interest on said taxes at the legal rate per annum that have been paid on said)) three years after the several disabilities cease to exist, reimburse the person or persons for taxes paid on, plus interest paid on the taxes at the legal rate per annum, and improvements to and costs expended on the vacant and unimproved land.

(2) For the purposes of this section, the term "lands held for any public purpose" includes, but is not limited to, plat greenbelts and open space areas dedicated to a public agency or to a bona fide homeowner's association.

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
