- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 7.69.050 and 1985 c 443 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Nothing contained in this chapter may be construed to provide
- 7 grounds for error in favor of a criminal defendant in a criminal
- 8 proceeding, nor may anything in this chapter be construed to grant a
- 9 new cause of action or remedy against the state, its political
- 10 subdivisions, law enforcement agencies, or prosecuting attorneys.
- 11 Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the failure of a
- 12 person to make a reasonable effort to ensure that victims, survivors,
- 13 and witnesses under this chapter have the rights enumerated in RCW
- 14 7.69.030 shall not result in civil liability against that person.
- 15 (2) The failure of a local law enforcement agency or prosecuting
- 16 attorney to inform a victim or survivor of a victim as required in RCW
- 17 7.69.030 (2) and (12) shall not result in civil liability unless the
- 18 local law enforcement agency or prosecuting attorney acted in bad faith
