- 1 AN ACT Relating to the fish and wildlife commission; amending RCW
- 2 77.04.030; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.04.030 and 1994 c 264 s 52 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The fish and wildlife commission consists of nine registered voters
- 7 of the state. In January of each odd-numbered year, the governor shall
- 8 appoint with the advice and consent of the senate two registered voters
- 9 to the commission to serve for terms of six years from that January or
- 10 until their successors are appointed and qualified. If a vacancy
- 11 occurs on the commission prior to the expiration of a term, the
- 12 governor shall appoint a registered voter within sixty days to complete
- 13 the term. Three members shall be residents of that portion of the
- 14 state lying east of the summit of the Cascade mountains, and three
- 15 shall be residents of that portion of the state lying west of the
- 16 summit of the Cascade mountains. Three additional members shall be
- 17 appointed at-large effective July 1, 1993; one of whom shall serve a
- 18 one and one-half year term to end December 31, 1994; one of whom shall
- 19 serve a three and one-half year term to end December 31, 1996; and one

- 1 of whom shall serve a five and one-half year term to end December 31,
- 2 1998. Thereafter all members are to serve a six-year term. No two
- 3 members may be residents of the same county. The legal office of the
- 4 commission is at the administrative office of the department in
- 5 Olympia.
- 6 When making appointments to the at-large positions, the governor
- 7 shall appoint to at least two of those positions persons who are
- 8 farmers and who have knowledge and an understanding of the relationship
- 9 between fish and wildlife populations and production of agricultural
- 10 <u>commodities</u>.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Upon the expiration of the terms or the
- 12 vacancies of the first two at-large member positions of the fish and
- 13 wildlife commission, the governor must appoint two people who are
- 14 farmers to the at-large positions of the fish and wildlife commission
- 15 in order to comply with RCW 77.04.030.
