1 AN ACT Relating to repairs at Olympic College; making an
2 appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The sum of three million six hundred fifty-
5 five thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
6 appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1997, from the state
7 building construction account to the state board for community and
8 technical colleges for the purpose of emergency repairs at Olympic
9 College. The appropriation shall be used for the following emergency
10 repairs:

11 (1) Two million four hundred ten thousand dollars to repair broken
12 underground pipes for the central heating system;

13 (2) One hundred seven thousand dollars to repair damaged roof beams
14 in the gymnasium caused by the December 1996 snow and ice storm; and

15 (3) One million one hundred thirty-eight thousand dollars to design
16 a new library building, provide temporary library space, and demolish
17 and clean up the existing library building destroyed by the 1996 snow
18 and ice storm.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
3 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
4 immediately.
