- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.44.200 and 1933 ex.s. c 62 s 36 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) No person shall sell any liquor to any person apparently under 7 the influence of liquor.
- 8 (2)(a) No person who is under the influence of liquor to the extent
- 9 that he or she is intoxicated may purchase or consume liquor on any
- 10 premises licensed by the board.
- 11 (b) As used in this section, "intoxicated" means:
- 12 (i) An impairment of a person's mental or physical faculties as a
- 13 result of alcoholic beverage use so as to diminish the person's ability
- 14 to think and act in a manner in which an ordinarily prudent and
- 15 cautious person, in full possession of his or her faculties and using
- 16 reasonable care, would act under like circumstances;
- 17 (ii) The condition of a person if the person has within the
- 18 previous twelve hours been denied the purchase of liquor on the grounds
- 19 the sale would violate this section;

- 9 (e) Notice of the prohibition against the purchase of liquor in 10 this subsection shall be posted conspicuously in every establishment 11 that sells liquor.
