- 1 AN ACT Relating to using state lottery moneys for compulsive
- 2 gambling education and awareness; amending RCW 9.46.071, 67.70.240, and
- 3 67.70.042; and making an appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.46.071 and 1994 c 218 s 6 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 The legislature recognizes that some individuals in this state are
- 8 problem or compulsive gamblers. Because the state promotes and
- 9 regulates gambling through the activities of the state lottery
- 10 commission, the Washington horse racing commission, and the Washington
- 11 state gambling commission, the state has the responsibility to continue
- 12 to provide resources for the support of services for problem and
- 13 compulsive gamblers. Therefore, the Washington state gambling
- 14 commission, the Washington horse racing commission, and the state
- 15 lottery commission shall jointly develop informational signs concerning
- 16 problem and compulsive gambling which include a toll-free hot line
- 17 number for problem and compulsive gamblers. The signs shall be placed
- 18 in the establishments of gambling licensees, horse racing licensees,
- 19 and lottery retailers.

- 1 The Washington state gambling commission shall adopt rules to
- 2 implement a program for the purpose of compulsive gambling education
- 3 <u>and awareness</u>.
- 4 **Sec. 2.** RCW 67.70.240 and 1995 3rd sp.s. c 1 s 105 are each 5 amended to read as follows:
- The moneys in the state lottery account shall be used only: (1)
- 7 For the payment of prizes to the holders of winning lottery tickets or
- 8 shares; (2) for purposes of making deposits into the reserve account
- 9 created by RCW 67.70.250 and into the lottery administrative account
- 10 created by RCW 67.70.260; (3) for purposes of making deposits into the
- 11 state's general fund; (4) ((for purposes of making deposits into the
- 12 housing trust fund under the provisions of section 7 of this 1987 act;
- 13 (5))) for distribution to a county for the purpose of paying the
- 14 principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to
- 15 construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including
- 16 reasonably necessary preconstruction costs; $((\frac{6}{}))$ for the
- 17 purchase and promotion of lottery games and game-related services and,
- 18 from the state lottery's advertising budget, for the purposes of
- 19 section 1 of this act; and $((\frac{7}{1}))$ (6) for the payment of agent
- 20 compensation. Three million dollars shall be distributed under
- 21 subsection (((5))) of this section during calendar year 1996.
- 22 During subsequent years, such distributions shall equal the prior
- 23 year's distributions increased by four percent. Distributions under
- 24 subsection (((5))) (4) of this section shall cease when the bonds
- 25 issued for the construction of the baseball stadium are retired, but
- 26 not more than twenty years after the tax under RCW 82.14.0485 is first
- 27 imposed.
- The office of financial management shall require the allotment of
- 29 all expenses paid from the account and shall report to the ways and
- 30 means committees of the senate and house of representatives any changes
- 31 in the allotments.
- 32 **Sec. 3.** RCW 67.70.042 and 1995 3rd sp.s. c 1 s 104 are each
- 33 amended to read as follows:
- The lottery commission shall conduct at least two but not more than
- 35 four scratch games with sports themes per year. These games are
- 36 intended to generate additional moneys sufficient to cover the
- 37 distributions under RCW 67.70.240($(\frac{(5)}{(5)})$) $(\frac{4}{(4)}$.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1999, from the state lottery account under RCW 67.70.240(5) to the Washington state gambling commission for the purposes of section 1 of this act.
