- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.26 RCW to read as follows: 5
- 6 Beginning February 1, 1999, and annually thereafter,
- transportation improvement board shall submit to the transportation
- committees of the senate and the house of representatives, proposed 8

- lists of projects for which funds are being requested for appropriation
- 10 from the following accounts: Transportation improvement account, urban
- arterial trust account, central Puget Sound public transportation 11
- 12 account, public transportation systems account, small city account, and
- 13 city hardship assistance account. The lists shall include, but not be 14 limited to, a brief description of the project, total expenditures by
