1 AN ACT Relating to transportation improvement board reporting
2 requirements; and adding a new section to chapter 47.26 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.26 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 Beginning February 1, 1999, and annually thereafter, the
7 transportation improvement board shall submit to the transportation
8 committees of the senate and the house of representatives, proposed
9 lists of projects for which funds are being requested for appropriation
10 from the following accounts: Transportation improvement account, urban
11 arterial trust account, central Puget Sound public transportation
12 account, public transportation systems account, small city account, and
13 city hardship assistance account. The lists shall include, but not be
14 limited to, a brief description of the project, total expenditures by
15 phase and biennium, funding requirements of other organizations,
16 priority rating, start date by phase, applicable state route or road
17 name, impacted county, and legislative district.
