- 1 AN ACT Relating to service credit; and amending RCW 41.50.165.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.50.165 and 1994 c 197 s 2 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
- 5 (1) Except for those affected by subsection (4) of this section, a member of a retirement system specified by RCW 41.50.030 and 28B.10.400 or((-,)) one previously established by the state but closed to new 8 membership, may, as provided in each retirement system:
  - (a) Establish allowable membership service not previously credited;
- 10 (b) Restore all or a part of that previously credited membership 11 service represented by withdrawn contributions; or
- 12 (c) Restore service credit represented by a lump sum payment in 13 lieu of benefits.
- 14 (2) Persons who previously have failed to:

- 15 (a) Establish service credit for service previously earned; or
- (b) Reestablish service credit by the restoration of withdrawn contributions or repayment of a lump sum payment in lieu of a benefit, may now establish or reestablish such service credit by paying the actuarial value of the resulting increase in their benefit in a manner

- defined by the department. <u>However</u>, <u>service performed under the provisions of RCW 28B.10.400 and not transferred to chapter 41.40 RCW under the provisions of RCW 41.40.501, decodified by section 4, chapter</u>
- 4 35, Laws of 1991, are eligible to be reestablished by this section. In
- 5 <u>addition</u>, <u>service performed and eligible for service credit under</u>
- 6 chapter 41.40 RCW, but not eligible for service credit authorized by
- 7 the provision of RCW 28B.10.400, are eligible to be established by this
- 8 <u>section.</u>
- 9 (3) Any establishment of service credit for service previously 10 rendered, restoration of service credit destroyed, or repayment of a 11 lump sum received in lieu of benefit must be completed prior to 12 retirement.
- 13 (4) Service credit is established for or restored to the period in 14 which the service credit is earned.
