- 1 AN ACT Relating to replacing the administrator of the office of
- 2 marine safety as an ex officio member of the board of pilotage
- 3 commissioners with a public member experienced in marine incident
- 4 investigation; and amending RCW 88.16.010.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 88.16.010 and 1991 c 200 s 1001 are each amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 (1) The board of pilotage commissioners of the state of Washington
- 9 is hereby created and shall consist of the assistant secretary of
- 10 marine transportation of the department of transportation of the state
- of Washington, or the assistant secretary's designee who shall be an
- 12 employee of the marine division, who shall be chairperson, ((the
- 13 administrator of the office of marine safety, or the administrator's
- 14 designee,)) and seven members appointed by the governor and confirmed
- 15 by the senate. Each of the appointed commissioners shall be appointed
- 16 for a term of four years from the date of the member's commission. No
- 17 person shall be eligible for appointment to the board unless that
- 18 person is at the time of appointment eighteen years of age or over and
- 19 a citizen of the United States and of the state of Washington. Two of

the appointed commissioners shall be pilots licensed under this chapter 1 and actively engaged in piloting upon the waters covered by this 2 3 chapter for at least three years immediately preceding the time of 4 appointment and while serving on the board. One pilot shall be from the Puget Sound pilotage district and one shall be from the Grays 5 Harbor pilotage district. Two of the appointed commissioners shall be 6 7 actively engaged in the ownership, operation, or management of deep sea 8 cargo and/or passenger carrying vessels for at least three years 9 immediately preceding the time of appointment and while serving on the 10 board. One of said shipping commissioners shall be a representative of American and one of foreign shipping. One of the commissioners shall 11 be a representative from a recognized environmental organization 12 concerned with marine waters. One of the commissioners shall have 13 14 experience in marine incident investigation. The remaining 15 commissioner((s)) shall be <u>a</u> person((s)) interested in and concerned with pilotage, maritime safety, and marine affairs, with broad 16 17 experience related to the maritime industry exclusive of experience as either a state licensed pilot or as a shipping representative. 18

- 19 (2) Any vacancy in an appointed position on the board shall be 20 filled by the governor for the remainder of the unfilled term, subject 21 to confirmation by the senate.
- 22 (3) Five members of the board shall constitute a quorum. At least 23 one pilot, one shipping representative, and one public member must be 24 present at every meeting. All commissioners and the chairperson shall 25 have a vote.
