- 1 AN ACT Relating to improving access for oral health care services
- 2 for rural and underserved populations; adding a new section to chapter
- 3 70.185 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 28B.115 RCW; and making
- 4 appropriations.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The sum of three hundred thousand dollars,
- 7 or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the
- 8 biennium ending June 30, 1999, from the general fund to the department
- 9 of health for the purpose of awarding community-based oral health
- 10 education and prevention grants. Such grants may be awarded to
- 11 community and migrant health centers, tribal clinics, or public health
- 12 jurisdictions. Grant applications for oral health education and
- 13 prevention grants must include: (1) An assessment of the community's
- 14 oral health education and prevention needs; (2) identification of the
- 15 population to be served; and (3) a description of the grant program's
- 16 predicted outcomes.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of three hundred thousand dollars,
- 18 or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the

- 1 biennium ending June 30, 1999, from the general fund to the University
- 2 of Washington for the school of dentistry's senior dental extern
- 3 program, dental hygiene degree completion program, and graduate
- 4 pediatric dental program to serve rural and underserved children
- 5 through training programs at community and migrant health centers,
- 6 community clinics, tribal clinics, and public health jurisdictions
- 7 throughout the state.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 70.185 RCW
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 The department shall utilize the available funds in the recruitment
- 11 and retention program to target dentists and dental hygienists who wish
- 12 to practice in remote and underserved areas of the state.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.115
- 14 RCW to read as follows:
- The board shall target dentists and dental hygienists who wish to
- 16 practice in remote and underserved areas of the state when allocating
- 17 funds for the loan repayment and scholarship program.
