- 1 AN ACT Relating to referrals to physical therapists from licensed
- 2 nurse practitioners; and amending RCW 18.74.010.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 18.74.010 and 1991 c 12 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Unless the context otherwise requires, the definitions in this 7 section apply throughout this chapter.
- 8 (1) "Board" means the board of physical therapy created by RCW 9 18.74.020.
- 10 (2) "Department" means the department of health.
- 11 (3) "Physical therapy" means the treatment of any bodily or mental
- 12 condition of any person by the use of the physical, chemical, and other
- 13 properties of heat, cold, air, light, water, electricity, sound,
- 14 massage, and therapeutic exercise, which includes posture and
- 15 rehabilitation procedures; the performance of tests and measurements of
- 16 neuromuscular function as an aid to the diagnosis or treatment of any
- 17 human condition; performance of treatments on the basis of test
- 18 findings after consultation with and periodic review by an authorized
- 19 health care practitioner except as provided in RCW 18.74.012;

- 1 supervision of selective forms of treatment by trained supportive
- 2 personnel; and provision of consultative services for health,
- 3 education, and community agencies. The use of Roentgen rays and radium
- 4 for diagnostic and therapeutic purposes, the use of electricity for
- 5 surgical purposes, including cauterization, and the use of spinal
- 6 manipulation or manipulative mobilization of the spine and its
- 7 immediate articulations, are not included under the term "physical
- 8 therapy" as used in this chapter.
- 9 (4) "Physical therapist" means a person who practices physical
- 10 therapy as defined in this chapter but does not include massage
- 11 operators as defined in RCW 18.108.010.
- 12 (5) "Secretary" means the secretary of health.
- 13 (6) Words importing the masculine gender may be applied to females.
- 14 (7) "Authorized health care practitioner" means and includes
- 15 licensed physicians, osteopathic physicians, chiropractors,
- 16 naturopaths, ((podiatrists, and)) podiatric physicians and surgeons,
- 17 dentists, and advanced registered nurse practitioners: PROVIDED,
- 18 HOWEVER, That nothing herein shall be construed as altering the scope
- 19 of practice of such practitioners as defined in their respective
- 20 licensure laws.
