- 1 AN ACT Relating to prevailing wage surveys; and amending RCW 2 39.12.015.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 39.12.015 and 1965 ex.s. c 133 s 2 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) To determine the prevailing rate of wage on public works
- 7 projects, the department of labor and industries shall contract with an
- 8 independent third party to conduct wage surveys and determine the
- 9 prevailing rate of wage for each relevant scope of work description
- 10 <u>issued</u> by the department. The surveys for each scope of work
- 11 description must be conducted at least annually and must survey an
- 12 equal number of employers who are subject to wage provisions for the
- 13 relevant scope of work description in a collective bargaining agreement
- 14 and employers who are not subject to such a collective bargaining
- 15 agreement.
- 16 (2) All determinations of the prevailing rate of wage shall be
- 17 ((made)) published by the industrial statistician of the department of
