- 11 **Sec. 2.** RCW 51.28.055 and 1984 c 159 s 2 are each amended to read

- 13 Claims for occupational disease or infection to be valid and
- 14 compensable must be filed within ((two)) one year((s)) following the
- 15 date the worker had written notice from a physician: (1) Of the
- 16 existence of his or her occupational disease, and (2) that a claim for
