- 1 AN ACT Relating to licensed midwives; amending RCW 18.50.005 and
- 2 18.50.010; adding new sections to chapter 18.50 RCW; and creating a new
- 3 section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that there is
- 6 ambiguity as to what the role of licensed midwives should be.
- 7 It is the intent of the legislature to clarify the understanding of
- 8 the original law that licensed midwives for care of low-risk maternal
- 9 clients only.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.50 RCW
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 The secretary shall adopt rules defining low-risk maternal clients
- 13 and establishing practice standards for midwives. These standards
- 14 shall not be less than those adopted for childbirth centers under
- 15 chapter 18.46 RCW.
- 16 Sec. 3. RCW 18.50.005 and 1991 c 3 s 102 are each amended to read
- 17 as follows:

- 1 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in
- 2 this section apply throughout this chapter:
- 3 (1) "Department" means the department of health.
- 4 (2) "Secretary" means the secretary of health.
- 5 (3) "Midwife" means a midwife licensed under this chapter.
- 6 (4) "Physician" means a physician licensed under chapter 18.57 or
- 7 18.71 RCW.
- 8 (5) "Practice of midwifery" means providing medical aid service for
- 9 <u>a fee or compensation to low-risk maternal clients as defined by the</u>
- 10 secretary by rule under section 2 of this act.
- 11 **Sec. 4.** RCW 18.50.010 and 1991 c 3 s 103 are each amended to read
- 12 as follows:
- 13 Any person shall be regarded as practicing midwifery within the
- 14 meaning of this chapter who shall render medical aid for a fee or
- 15 compensation to a woman during prenatal, intrapartum, and postpartum
- 16 stages or who shall advertise as a midwife by signs, printed cards, or
- 17 otherwise. Nothing shall be construed in this chapter to prohibit
- 18 gratuitous services. It shall be the duty of a midwife to consult
- 19 ((with)) and refer the patient to a physician whenever there are
- 20 significant deviations from normal in either the mother or the infant.
- 21 The physician may refer the patient back to the midwife.
- 22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 18.50 RCW
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 A licensed midwife who provides services to a person who is not a
- 25 low-risk client as defined by the secretary under section 2 of this act
- 26 is ineligible for coverage under the joint underwriting association
- 27 established in chapter 48.87 RCW.
- 28 NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. A new section is added to chapter 18.50 RCW
- 29 to read as follows:
- To knowingly treat a person who is not a low-risk client as defined
- 31 by the secretary under section 2 of this act constitutes unprofessional
- 32 conduct for the purposes of chapter 18.130 RCW.
