1 AN ACT Relating to a mechanism for financing stadium and exhibition
2 centers and education technology grants; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that regional and
5 state economies are enhanced by having facilities to accommodate both
6 sporting events and exhibits.

7 The legislature further finds that the direct and indirect economic
8 benefits of professional sports and exhibits generate revenue and jobs
9 to the economy.

10 The legislature further finds that a fair, balanced funding
11 partnership between the private sector, the public sector, and the
12 facility users is vital.

13 The legislature further finds that any construction of the facility
14 and operation of concessions within the facility shall include thirty-
15 three percent representation of minority-owned businesses.

1 The legislature further finds that the developer and master tenant
2 of the facility shall take steps necessary to mitigate the impact of
3 the facility on the surrounding areas.
