
SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2193

1 AN ACT Relating to the joint center for higher education
2 transportation and parking fees and higher education parking fees;
3 amending RCW 43.01.236; and adding a new section to chapter 28B.25 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.25 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 (1) The joint center board may:

8 (a) Adopt rules governing pedestrian traffic and vehicular traffic
9 and parking upon lands and facilities of the center;

10 (b) Establish, collect, and retain parking fees for employees and
11 students;

12 (c) Adjudicate matters involving parking infractions internally;
13 and

14 (d) Collect and retain any penalties for parking infractions.

15 (2) If the rules adopted under subsection (1) of this section
16 provide for internal adjudication of parking infractions, a person
17 charged with a parking infraction who deems himself or herself
18 aggrieved by the final decision in an internal adjudication may, within
19 ten days after written notice of the final decision, appeal by filing

1 a written notice thereof with the joint center board. Documents
2 relating to the appeal shall immediately be forwarded to the district
3 court in the county in which the offense was committed, which court
4 shall have jurisdiction over such offense and such appeal shall be
5 heard de novo.

6 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.01.236 and 1995 c 215 s 5 are each amended to read
7 as follows:

8 All institutions of higher education as defined under RCW
9 28B.10.016 and the joint center for higher education under chapter
10 28B.25 RCW are exempt from the requirements under RCW ((43.01.225))
11 43.01.240.
