- 1 AN ACT Relating to wetlands technical assistance; amending RCW
- 2 90.60.020; and adding new sections to chapter 90.60 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.60.020 and 1995 c 347 s 602 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter.
- 8 (1) "Center" means the permit assistance center established in the 9 ((commission [department])) department by RCW 90.60.030.
- 10 (2) "Coordinating permit agency" means the permit agency that has 11 the greatest overall jurisdiction over a project.
- 12 (3) "Department" means the department of ecology.
- 13 (4) "Governmental agency" means the department of ecology, the
- 14 department of fish and wildlife, counties, cities, and towns; and any
- 15 federal agency upon the agreement of the agency to be subject to this
- 16 <u>chapter</u>.
- 17 (5) "Participating permit agency" means a permit agency, other than
- 18 the coordinating permit agency, that is responsible for the issuance of
- 19 a permit for a project.

- 1 (((5))) (6) "Permit" means any license, certificate, registration,
- 2 permit, or other form of authorization required by a permit agency to
- 3 engage in a particular activity.
- 4 (((6))) (7) "Permit agency" means:
- 5 (a) The department of ecology, an air pollution control authority,
- 6 the department of natural resources, the department of fish and
- 7 wildlife, and the department of health; and
- 8 (b) Any other state or federal agency or county, city, or town that
- 9 participates at the request of the permit applicant and upon the
- 10 agency's agreement to be subject to this chapter.
- 11  $((\frac{7}{1}))$  (8) "Project" means an activity, the conduct of which
- 12 requires permits from one or more permit agencies.
- (9) "Property owner" means a person who has a legal interest in a
- 14 piece of property or has entered a purchase and sale agreement for a
- 15 piece of property.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 90.60 RCW
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (1) At the request of a property owner, the center shall provide
- 19 technical assistance on wetlands issues by:
- 20 (a) Assisting property owners in identifying whether wetlands are
- 21 present and the general location and extent of wetlands on the property
- 22 in question;
- 23 (b) Assisting property owners in identifying the federal, state,
- 24 and local permits and regulations that may apply to the property;
- 25 (c) Reviewing wetland determinations and delineations and providing
- 26 a nonbinding evaluation of whether the decisions are technically
- 27 correct; and
- 28 (d) Facilitating the resolution of disputes between the property
- 29 owner and governmental agencies on wetlands issues.
- 30 (2) The department shall complete the evaluation authorized by
- 31 subsection (1)(c) of this section within thirty days of a written
- 32 request and shall conclude any dispute resolution facilitation under
- 33 subsection (1)(d) of this section within thirty days of a written
- 34 request. The time periods in this subsection may be extended if the
- 35 parties agree, additional information is needed, or a site visit is
- 36 necessary and environmental conditions necessitate additional time.
- 37 (3) The staff assigned to provide technical assistance on wetlands

- 1 (a) Be located in the regional offices of the department;
- 2 (b) Have as their sole function the provision of assistance 3 authorized by this section and no regulatory function;
- (c) Have the necessary expertise to advise property owners and governmental agencies on wetlands technical issues. When the department determines that the expertise of a soils scientist would be desirable, the department may contract with a soils scientist certified or registered by a professional body determined by the department to have the capability to assess expertise in soils and related matters.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 90.60 RCW to read as follows:
- By December 1, 2000, the center shall submit a report to the appropriate committees of both houses of the legislature detailing the following information regarding the provision of technical assistance on wetlands issues:
- 16 (1) The number of instances in which the assistance of the center 17 has been requested and the type of assistance requested;
- 18 (2) An evaluation of the value of the service to property owners 19 and governmental agencies; and
- 20 (3) Recommendations for any changes needed to make the assistance 21 more effective.
