1 AN ACT Relating to interest on judgments; amending RCW 10.82.090;  
2 and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 10.82.090 and 1995 c 291 s 7 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 Financial obligations imposed in a judgment in a criminal case  
7 shall bear interest from the date of the judgment until payment(~~(, at~~  
8 ~~the rate applicable to civil judgments))~~ is paid in full. Interest  
9 rates on judgments shall not exceed six percent in any twelve-month  
10 period. All nonrestitution interest retained by the court shall be  
11 split twenty-five percent to the state treasurer for deposit in the  
12 public safety and education account as provided in RCW 43.08.250,  
13 twenty-five percent to the state treasurer for deposit in the judicial  
14 information system account as provided in RCW 2.68.020, twenty-five  
15 percent to the county current expense fund, and twenty-five percent to  
16 the county current expense fund to fund local courts.

1        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**    This act takes effect July 1, 1998.
