- 1 AN ACT Relating to access to specialty health care services; adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 48.43 RCW; adding a new section to chapter
- 3 41.05 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that because of
- 6 taxpayers' long-standing support, Washington has developed and
- 7 maintains excellent publicly funded hospitals that provide exceptional
- 8 physician training and the most advanced specialty care available.
- 9 However, since these hospitals are in only one area of the state, which
- 10 is not centrally located, many citizens, who support these hospitals
- 11 with their state and federal taxes, are denied timely and appropriate
- 12 access to needed medical advice. It is the intent of the legislature
- 13 to ensure that physicians throughout the state have access to the
- 14 unique consultation services of these hospitals.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 48.43 RCW
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (1) For the purposes of this section:

- 1 (a) "Hospital" means a hospital that is licensed under RCW
- 2 70.41.090 and trains physicians and that: (i) Was established pursuant
- 3 to chapter 36.62 RCW; (ii) is administered by the regents of the
- 4 University of Washington; or (iii) is providing tertiary health
- 5 services, as defined in RCW 70.38.025, to children;
- 6 (b) "Physician" means a physician licensed under chapter 18.57 or 7 18.71 RCW.
- 8 (2) Every health carrier that offers or provides coverage for
- 9 hospital services shall permit a physician who is treating a covered
- 10 person to access timely medical advice and consultation from
- 11 appropriate hospital staff, consistent with the administrative
- 12 procedures of the carrier. This section does not establish a standard
- 13 of medical care nor authorize unnecessary medical services.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 (1) For the purposes of this section:
- 17 (a) "Hospital" means a hospital that is licensed under RCW
- 18 70.41.090 and trains physicians and that: (i) Was established pursuant
- 19 to chapter 36.62 RCW; (ii) is administered by the regents of the
- 20 University of Washington; or (iii) is providing tertiary health
- 21 services, as defined in RCW 70.38.025, to children;
- 22 (b) "Physician" means a physician licensed under chapter 18.57 or
- 23 18.71 RCW.
- 24 (2) Every health plan offered pursuant to this chapter or chapter
- 25 70.47 RCW shall permit a physician who is treating a covered person to
- 26 access timely medical advice and consultation from appropriate hospital
- 27 staff, consistent with the administrative procedures of the authority.
- 28 This section does not establish a standard of medical care nor
- 29 authorize unnecessary medical services.
