- 1 AN ACT Relating to disabled veteran license plates; and amending
- 2 RCW 73.04.110.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 73.04.110 and 1987 c 98 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Any person who is a veteran ((as defined in RCW 41.04.005)) who
- 7 submits to the department of licensing satisfactory proof of a service-
- 8 connected disability rating from the veterans administration or the
- 9 military service from which the veteran was discharged and:
- 10 (1) Has lost the use of both hands or one foot;
- 11 (2) Was captured and incarcerated for more than twenty-nine days by
- 12 an enemy of the United States during a period of war with the United
- 13 States;
- 14 (3) Has become blind in both eyes as the result of military
- 15 service; or
- 16 (4) Is rated by the veterans administration or the military service
- 17 from which the veteran was discharged and is receiving service-
- 18 connected compensation at the one hundred percent rate that is expected
- 19 to exist for more than one year;

- 1 is entitled to regular or special license plates issued by the
- 2 department of licensing. The special license plates shall bear
- 3 distinguishing marks, letters, or numerals indicating that the motor
- 4 vehicle is owned by a disabled veteran or former prisoner of war. This
- 5 license shall be issued annually for one personal use vehicle without
- 6 payment of any license fees or excise tax thereon. Whenever any person
- 7 who has been issued license plates under the provisions of this section
- 8 applies to the department for transfer of the plates to a subsequently
- 9 acquired motor vehicle, a transfer fee of five dollars shall be charged
- 10 in addition to all other appropriate fees. The department may
- 11 periodically verify the one hundred percent rate as provided in
- 12 subsection (4) of this section.
- 13 Any person who has been issued free motor vehicle license plates
- 14 under this section prior to July 1, 1983, shall continue to be eligible
- 15 for the annual free license plates.
- 16 For the purposes of this section, "blind" means the definition of
- 17 "blind" used by the state of Washington in determining eligibility for
- 18 financial assistance to the blind under Title 74 RCW.
- 19 Any unauthorized use of a special plate is a gross misdemeanor.
