- 1 AN ACT Relating to contracting with entities that provide services
- 2 for the WorkFirst program that are normally provided by civil servants;
- 3 amending RCW 74.08A.290 and 41.06.380; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.08A.290 and 1997 c 58 s 316 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) It is the intent of the legislature that the department is 8 authorized to engage in competitive contracting using performance-based
- 9 contracts to provide all work activities ((authorized)) defined in this
- 10 chapter ((58, Laws of 1997, including the job search component
- 11 authorized in section 312 of this act)).
- 12 (2) The department may use competitive performance-based
- 13 contracting to select which vendors will participate in the WorkFirst
- 14 program. Performance-based contracts shall be awarded based on factors
- 15 that include but are not limited to the criteria listed in RCW
- 16 74.08A.410, past performance of the contractor, demonstrated ability to
- 17 perform the contract effectively, financial strength of the contractor,
- 18 and merits of the proposal for services submitted by the contractor.
- 19 Contracts shall be made without regard to whether the contractor is a

- public or private entity. For the purpose of implementing this chapter, the department may contract with private or public entities for services that are ordinarily provided by and capable of being provided by civil servants regardless of any rights, express or
- 5 implied, created by the state civil service law, chapter 41.06 RCW.
- 6 (3) The department may contract for an evaluation of the 7 competitive contracting practices and outcomes to be performed by an 8 independent entity with expertise in government privatization and 9 competitive strategies. The evaluation shall include quarterly 10 progress reports to the fiscal committees of the legislature and to the 11 governor, starting at the first quarter after the effective date of the 12 first competitive contract and ending two years after the effective
- (4) The department shall seek independent assistance in developing contracting strategies to implement this section. Assistance may include but is not limited to development of contract language, design of requests for proposal, developing full cost information on government services, evaluation of bids, and providing for equal competition between private and public entities.
- 20 **Sec. 2.** RCW 41.06.380 and 1979 ex.s. c 46 s 2 are each amended to 21 read as follows:
- 22 (1) Nothing contained in this chapter shall prohibit any 23 department, as defined in RCW 41.06.020, from purchasing services by 24 contract with individuals or business entities if such services were 25 regularly purchased by valid contract by such department prior to April 23, 1979: PROVIDED, That no such contract may be executed or renewed 26 27 if it would have the effect of terminating classified employees or classified employee positions existing at the time of the execution or 28 29 renewal of the contract.
- 30 (2) This chapter shall not be construed to prohibit the department 31 of social and health services from carrying out the provisions of 32 chapter 74.08A RCW.
- 33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate 34 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
