1 AN ACT Relating to requiring stops at intersections with  
2 nonfunctioning signal lights; and adding a new section to chapter 46.61  
3 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7 Except when directed to proceed by a flagger, police officer, or  
8 fire fighter, the driver of a vehicle approaching an intersection  
9 controlled with a traffic control signal that is not displaying a  
10 green, red, or yellow indication to that approaching vehicle, shall  
11 stop and yield the right of way in accordance with RCW 46.61.180(1) and  
12 46.61.185.
