1 AN ACT Relating to funding breast and cervical cancer screening for
2 low-income women; and making an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The sum of one million five hundred thousand
5 dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for
6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, from the general fund to the
7 department of health for the purpose of making breast and cervical
8 cancer screening available to low-income women by replacing federal
9 revenue that was lost due to a change in the federal funding formula.
