1 WHEREAS, Issues raised during this legislative session have 2 underscored that there is a need to provide properly for those who are 3 currently giving service or have given service to their state and 4 country; and

WHEREAS, Especially due to proposed substantial federal cuts in programs, the veterans, members of the active duty military forces, and members of the national guard and reserve components in Washington state, must have consideration given to their unique concerns and the programs designed for their assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That a Veterans and Military Affairs Task Force is created; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the task force consist of seven members, one member from each caucus of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate, one member from each caucus of the House of Representatives, Speaker appointed by the of the House of Representatives, one member appointed by the Washington National Guard, one member appointed by the Director of the Department of Veterans Affairs, and one member to represent federal military installations in the state appointed by the joint action of the President of the Senate
