- 1 TO THE HONORABLE WILLIAM J. CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED
- 2 STATES, AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE

OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF

- 4 THE UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, The state of Washington and other states have initiated
- 9 litigation against the tobacco industry seeking injunctive relief along
- 10 with the recovery of penalties and damages for the alleged illegal
- 11 conduct of the industry. Claims include the recovery of damages for
- 12 violation of consumer protection and antitrust laws, for common law
- 13 conspiracy, and for expenditure of public funds for health care
- 14 services; and

- 15 WHEREAS, The tobacco industry has agreed to a proposed global
- 16 settlement of the states' litigation which includes the recovery by
- 17 states of substantial damages. The proposed settlement has been
- 18 referred to congress for implementation; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Since the states have initiated litigation and settlement
- 20 of legal claims for violation of a number of state laws, they should
- 21 recover their full measure of damages in the proposed settlement

- 1 without any offset or withholding by the federal government.
- 2 Specifically, the Federal Department of Health and Human Services does
- 3 not and should not have a claim to any portion of the funds received by
- 4 the states as damages, based on receipt by the states of federal funds
- 5 for Medicaid costs;
- 6 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that congress
- 7 enact legislation which would specify that no portion of the funds
- 8 received by the states as part of the global settlement or any other
- 9 resolution of tobacco litigation be withheld, offset, or claimed by the
- 10 federal government, the Department of Health and Human Services, or any
- 11 other federal agency.
