- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) Any person or entity, other than those
- 5 listed in subsection (2) of this section, issuing an identification
- 6 card that purports to identify the holder as a resident of this or any
- 7 other state and that contains at least a name, photograph, and date of
- 8 birth, must label the card "not official proof of identification" in
- 9 flourescent yellow ink, on the face of the card, and in not less than
- 10 fourteen-point font. The background color of the card must be a color
- 11 other than the color used for official Washington state driver's
- 12 licenses and identicards.
- 13 (2) This section does not apply to the following persons and
