1 AN ACT Relating to the monitoring of supervised offenders under the
2 jurisdiction of the state department of corrections; adding a new
3 section to chapter 43.10 RCW; and creating new sections.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that increased
6 communications between local law enforcement officers and the state
7 department of corrections' community corrections officers improves
8 public safety through shared monitoring and supervision of offenders
9 living in the community under the jurisdiction of the department of
10 corrections.

11 Participating local law enforcement agencies and the local offices
12 of the department of corrections have implemented the supervision
13 management and recidivist tracking program, whereby each entity
14 provides mutual assistance in supervising offenders living within the
15 boundaries of local law enforcement agencies. The supervision
16 management and recidivist tracking program has helped local law
17 enforcement solve crimes faster or prevented future criminal activity
18 by reporting offender's sentence violations in a more timely manner to
19 community corrections officers by rapid and comprehensive electronic

1 sharing of information regarding supervised offenders. The expansion
2 of the supervision management and recidivist tracking program will
3 improve public safety throughout the state.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.10 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) There is created, as a component of the homicide investigative
7 tracking system, a supervision management and recidivist tracking
8 system called the SMART system. The office of the attorney general may
9 contract with any state, local, or private agency necessary for
10 implementation of and training for supervision management and
11 recidivist tracking program partnerships for development and operation
12 of a state-wide computer linkage between the attorney general's
13 homicide investigative tracking system, local police departments, and
14 the state department of corrections. Dormant information in the
15 supervision management and recidivist tracking system shall be
16 automatically archived after seven years. The department of
17 corrections shall notify the attorney general when each person is no
18 longer under its supervision.

19 (2) As used in this section, unless the context requires otherwise:

20 (a) "Dormant" means there have been no inquiries by the department
21 of corrections or law enforcement with regard to an active supervision
22 case or an active criminal investigation in the past seven years.

23 (b) "Archived" means information which is not in the active data
24 base and can only be retrieved for use in an active criminal
25 investigation.

26 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The homicide investigative tracking system
27 and the supervision management and recidivist tracking system are tools
28 for the administration of criminal justice and these systems may not be
29 used for any other purpose.

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
