WHEREAS, The Battleship U.S.S. Missouri (BB 63) is the solitary 1 2 identifiable symbol of the end of World War II for both the 3 servicemen and women who served overseas during that period and the millions of home front defense workers; and 4 5 WHEREAS, This intrinsic historical vessel is presently moored on the mainland of the contiguous states of the union where the majority 6 7 of veterans and home front defense workers and their descendants 8 reside and are economically able to visit and observe significance of the U.S.S. Missouri's involvement in ending the most 9 important event of the 20th century; and 10 WHEREAS, The youth of the United States of America, the future 11 12 leaders of this republic, will learn from and appreciate the 13 sacrifices for freedom which the U.S.S. Missouri represents; and 14 WHEREAS, The Missouri on the Mainland Committee (MOM) has been 15 duly organized and proposes that the Battleship U.S.S. Missouri (BB 16 63) be moored at a suitable location on the mainland to provide 17 accessibility for the majority of the American public to savor a 18 taste of freedom and their heritage; 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BERESOLVED, That the ΙT House of Representatives support the action and proposal of the Missouri on 20 the Mainland Committee (MOM), and respectfully request that the joint 21 22 houses of Congress of the United States of America enact appropriate 23 legislation to retain the Battleship U.S.S. Missouri (BB 63) at a selected site on the mainland; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be 25 immediately transmitted by the Chief Clerk of 26 the House 27 Representatives to the Honorable William J. Clinton, President of the
