1 AN ACT Relating to personal service contracts; amending RCW
2 42.52.030; and adding a new section to chapter 39.29 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 39.29 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 No member of the legislature may enter into a personal service
7 contract as defined in this chapter.

8 **Sec. 2.** RCW 42.52.030 and 1996 c 213 s 3 are each amended to read
9 as follows:

10 (1) No state officer or state employee, except as provided in
11 subsections (2) and (3) of this section, may be beneficially
12 interested, directly or indirectly, in a contract, sale, lease,
13 purchase, or grant that may be made by, through, or is under the
14 supervision of the officer or employee, in whole or in part, or accept,
15 directly or indirectly, any compensation, gratuity, or reward from any
16 other person beneficially interested in the contract, sale, lease,
17 purchase, or grant.

1 (2) No officer or employee of an institution of higher education or
2 of the Spokane intercollegiate research and technology institute,
3 except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, may be
4 beneficially interested, directly or indirectly, in a contract or grant
5 that may be made by, through, or is under the supervision of the
6 officer or employee, in whole or in part, or accept, directly or
7 indirectly, any compensation, gratuity, or reward from any other person
8 beneficially interested in the contract or grant, unless the
9 institution of higher education or the Spokane intercollegiate research
10 and technology institute has in effect a written administrative process
11 to identify and manage, reduce, or eliminate conflicting interests with
12 respect to such transactions as adopted pursuant to the national
13 science investigator financial disclosure (GPM 510) 1995 and the public
14 health service regulations, 42 C.F.R. Part 50 and 45 C.F.R. Subtitle A
15 as each of those regulations existed on June 6, 1996, and the state
16 employee or state officer has complied with such policy.

17 (3) No state officer or state employee may participate in a
18 transaction involving the state in his or her official capacity with a
19 person of which the officer or employee is an officer, agent, employee,
20 or member, or in which the officer or employee owns a beneficial
21 interest, except that an officer or employee of an institution of
22 higher education or the Spokane intercollegiate research and technology
23 institute may serve as an officer, agent, employee, or member, or on
24 the board of directors, board of trustees, advisory board, or committee
25 or review panel for any nonprofit institute, foundation, or fundraising
26 entity; and may serve as a member of an advisory board, committee, or
27 review panel for a governmental or other nonprofit entity.

28 (4) No member of the legislature may enter into a personal service
29 contract as defined in RCW 39.29.006.

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
