- 9 often be accomplished through cooperative partnerships between

- 9 (1) Any person applying for the issuance of a new permit or 10 modification of an existing permit under RCW 90.48.160 or 90.48.260 may 11 submit the application with a draft permit and fact sheet.
- (2) The department shall approve or deny the permit proposal within forty-five days of submission if no public hearing is required, or within ninety days of submission if a public hearing is required. The department may seek to negotiate a permit proposal with the applicant if both parties agree to the process. The department retains full authority under this chapter to approve, modify, or disapprove any
