- 3 (3) A person whose license has not been renewed for four years 4 shall be required to submit an application, fee, meet current licensing requirements, and pass the applicable examination or examinations 5 before the license may be reinstated: PROVIDED, That the director may 6 waive this requirement for good cause shown. To renew a salon/shop, booth renter, personal service operator, or mobile operator license,

- the licensee shall provide proof of insurance as required by RCW 9 10 18.16.175(1)(h).
