- 1 AN ACT Relating to motor vehicle excise tax exemptions; adding a

- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.44 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Motor homes, as defined under RCW 46.04.305, owned by persons who are eligible under this section are exempt from one-half of the taxes imposed in RCW 82.44.020 (1) and (2). 8
- 9 (2) A person is eligible under this section if the person meets the 10 qualifications in (a) and (b) of this subsection.
- 11 (a)(i) The person is at least sixty-two years of age; or
- 12 (ii) The person is disabled as defined by the social security 13 administration and receives social security benefits for 14 disability, or any other benefits for that disability from any other 15 governmental or nongovernmental source, or is entitled to benefits for developmental disability under RCW 71A.10.020(2) due to unemployability 16 17 full time at the minimum wage, or is legally blind or profoundly deaf, or has been issued a card, decal, or special license plate for a
