- 1 AN ACT Relating to improving access for oral health care services
- 2 for rural and underserved populations; adding a new section to chapter

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The sum of three hundred thousand dollars,
- 7 or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the
- 8 biennium ending June 30, 1999, from the general fund to the department
- 9 of health for the purpose of awarding community-based oral health
- 10 grants that may fund sealant programs, education, prevention, and other
- 11 oral health interventions. Such grants may be awarded to state or
- 12 federally funded community and migrant health centers, tribal clinics,
- 13 or public health jurisdictions. Priority shall be given to communities
- 14 with established oral health coalitions. Grant applications for oral
- 15 health education and prevention grants must include: (1) An assessment
- 16 of the community's oral health education and prevention needs; (2)
- 17 identification of the population to be served; and (3) a description of
- 18 the grant program's predicted outcomes.

The sum of three hundred thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1999, from the general fund to the University of Washington for the school of dentistry's senior dental extern program, dental hygiene degree completion program, and graduate pediatric dental program to serve rural and underserved children through training programs at Yakima valley farmworkers clinic, Yakima

- and deficient of reacting services, and other beate or reacting ranges
