- 1 AN ACT Relating to extending the 4.7187 percent state property tax
- 2 levy reduction; amending RCW 84.55.012; adding a new section to chapter
- 3 84.55 RCW; creating a new section; providing for submission of this act
- 4 to a vote of the people; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 84.55.012 and 1995 2nd sp.s. c 13 s 2 are each amended 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) The state property tax levy for collection in 1996 shall be
- 9 reduced by 4.7187 percent of the levy amount that would otherwise be
- 10 allowed under this chapter without regard to this section or any other
- 11 tax reduction legislation enacted in 1995.
- 12 (2) ((The tax reduction provided in this section is in addition to
- 13 any other tax reduction legislation that may be enacted by the
- 14 legislature.
- (3)) State levies for collection after ((1996)) 1997 shall be set
- 16 at the amount that would be allowed otherwise under this chapter if the
- 17 state ((levy)) <u>levies</u> for collection in 1996 <u>and 1997</u> had been set
- 18 without the reduction under subsection (1) of this section.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 84.55 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 The state property tax levy for collection in 1998 shall be reduced
- 4 by 4.7187 percent of the levy amount that would otherwise be allowed
- 5 under this chapter without regard to this section.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Section 1 of this act applies to taxes
- 7 levied for collection in 1997.
- 8 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. Section 1 of this act is necessary for the
- 9 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or
- 10 support of the state government and its existing public institutions,
- 11 and takes effect immediately.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** The secretary of state shall submit section
- 13 2 of this act to the people for their adoption and ratification, or
- 14 rejection, at the next general election to be held in this state, in
- 15 accordance with Article II, section 1 of the state Constitution and the
- 16 laws adopted to facilitate its operation.
