- 1 AN ACT Relating to surface mining; and amending RCW 78.44.151,
- 2 78.44.171, and 78.44.910.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 78.44.151 and 1993 c 518 s 23 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The department and the permit holder may modify the reclamation plan at any time during the term of the permit for any of the following
- 8 reasons:
- 9 (1) To modify the requirements so that they do not conflict with 10 existing or new laws;
- 11 (2) If the department and permit holder jointly determine (s) that
- 12 the previously adopted reclamation plan is impossible or impracticable
- 13 to implement and maintain; or
- 14 (3) The previously approved reclamation plan is not accomplishing
- 15 the intent of this chapter as determined by the department and permit
- 16 <u>holder jointly</u>.
- 17 Modified reclamation plans shall be reviewed by the department as
- 18 lead agency under SEPA. Such SEPA analyses shall consider only those
- 19 impacts relating directly to the proposed modifications. Copies of

- 3 **Sec. 2.** RCW 78.44.171 and 1993 c 518 s 22 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
- 5 Reclamation permits shall be transferred to a subsequent permit
- 6 holder and the department shall release the former permit holder from
- 7 the duties imposed by this chapter if((÷
- 8 $\frac{(1)}{(1)}$) both permit holders comply with all rules of the department
- 9 addressing requirements for transferring a permit((; and
- 10 (2) Unless waived by the department, the mine and all others
- 11 operated by both the former and subsequent permit holders and their
- 12 principal officers or owners are in compliance with this chapter and
- 13 rules)).
- 14 **Sec. 3.** RCW 78.44.910 and 1993 c 518 s 36 are each amended to read
- 15 as follows:
- Miners and permit holders shall not be required to reclaim any
- 17 segment where all surface mining was completed prior to January 1,
- 18 1971. However, the department shall make an effort to reclaim
- 19 previously abandoned or completed surface mining segments. However,
- 20 the department shall not require an applicant to reclaim lands not
- 21 under his or her control.
