- 1 AN ACT Relating to public school license plates; amending RCW
- 2 46.16.301 and 46.16.313; adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW;
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW; and adding a new section to
- 4 chapter 28A.150 RCW.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 "Public school license plates" mean license plates that display a
- 9 symbol of public schools in the state.
- 10 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.16.301 and 1995 3rd sp.s. c 1 s 102 are each
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (1) The department may create, design, and issue special license
- 13 plates that may be used in lieu of regular or personalized license
- 14 plates for motor vehicles required to display two motor vehicle license
- 15 plates, excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon
- 16 terms and conditions established by the department. The special plates
- 17 may:
- 18 (a) Denote the age or type of vehicle; or

(b) Denote special activities or interests; or

- 2 (c) Denote the status, or contribution or sacrifice for the United 3 States, the state of Washington, or the citizens of the state of 4 Washington, of a registered owner of that vehicle; ((or))
- 5 (d) Display a depiction of the name and mascot or symbol of a state 6 university, regional university, or state college as defined in RCW 7 28B.10.016; or
  - (e) Display a symbol of the public schools in the state.
- 9 (2) The department shall create, design, and issue a special 10 baseball stadium license plate that may be used in lieu of regular or personalized license plates for motor vehicles required to display two 11 motor vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles registered under 12 13 chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the department. The special plates shall commemorate the construction of 14 15 a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485. The department shall 16 also issue to each recipient of a special baseball stadium license 17 plate a certificate of participation in the construction of the baseball stadium. 18
- 19 (3) The department has the sole discretion to determine whether or 20 not to create, design, or issue any series of special license plates, other than the special baseball stadium license plate under subsection 21 (2) of this section, and whether any interest or status merits the 22 issuance of a series of special license plates. 23 In making this 24 determination, the department shall consider whether or not an interest 25 or status contributes or has contributed significantly to the public 26 health, safety, or welfare of the citizens of the United States or of 27 this state or to their significant benefit, or whether the interest or status is recognized by the United States, this state, or other states, 28 29 in other settings or contexts. The department may also consider the 30 potential number of persons who may be eligible for the plates and the cost and efficiency of producing limited numbers of the plates. 31 design of a special license plate shall conform to all requirements for 32 33 plates for the type of vehicle for which it is issued, as provided elsewhere in this chapter. 34
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW to read as follows:

- 1 (1) The department, in consultation with the state arts commission, 2 shall design a public schools license plate based on submissions from 3 students in public schools.
- 4 (2) Beginning January 1, 1998, the department shall issue license 5 plates depicting a symbol of public schools.
- 6 **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.16.313 and 1996 c 165 s 506 are each amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 (1) The department may establish a fee for each type of special 9 license plates issued under RCW 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c) in an amount calculated to offset the cost of production of the special 10 license plates and the administration of this program. The fee shall 11 not exceed thirty-five dollars and is in addition to all other fees 12 required to register and license the vehicle for which the plates have 13 14 been requested. All such additional special license plate fees 15 collected by the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the motor vehicle fund. 16
- (2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 17 18 application, registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle, 19 the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay a fee of thirty The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 20 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 21 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus 22 23 the cost of plate production, shall be remitted to the custody of the 24 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. 25 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890. 26
- (3) Except as set forth under subsection (4) of this section, in 27 addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application, 28 29 registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty 30 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 31 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 32 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus 33 34 the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued 35 36 by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while 37

the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund.

- 3 (4) Until June 30, 1997, in addition to all fees and taxes required 4 to be paid upon application, registration, and renewal registration of 5 a motor vehicle, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an 6 7 amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 8 subsection for license plate administration and collection expenses 9 incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed to a 10 county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined 11 in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction 12 costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After 13 14 this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state 15 general fund.
- 16 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application, registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle, 17 18 the holder of a public schools license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 19 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 20 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus 21 the cost of plate production, shall be remitted to the custody of the 22 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state 23 24 treasurer shall remit the proceeds to the appropriate public school district, as designated by the public school license plate applicant. 25
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.150 RCW to read as follows:

A public school license plate fund is established in the custody of 28 29 the state treasurer for all receipts from public school license plates. 30 The state treasurer shall remit the proceeds on a quarterly basis to the appropriate public school district, as designated by the public 31 school license plate applicant. If the applicant fails to designate a 32 public school district, the state treasurer shall distribute the funds 33 34 among the school districts of the state. Expenditures of funds made to public school districts must be approved by the superintendent of the 35
