- 1 AN ACT Relating to coercion; and amending RCW 9A.36.070.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.36.070 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.36.070 are 4 each amended to read as follows:
- (1) A person is guilty of coercion if by use of a threat he <u>or she</u> 6 <u>intentionally</u> compels or induces a person to engage in conduct which 7 the latter has a legal right to abstain from, or to abstain from
- 8 conduct which he or she has a legal right to engage in.
- 9 (2) "Threat" as used in this section means:
- 10 (a) To communicate, directly or indirectly, the intent immediately
- 11 to use force against any person who is present at the time; or
- 12 (b) Threats as defined in RCW 9A.04.110(25)(a), (b), or (c).
- 13 (3) Coercion is a gross misdemeanor.
