- 1 AN ACT Relating to tobacco prevention programs for youth; adding a
- 2 new section to chapter 82.24 RCW; adding new sections to chapter 43.70
- 3 RCW; creating a new section; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the health impact
- 6 of the use of tobacco products continues to be a major problem in
- 7 Washington state. The legislature intends to aggressively address this
- 8 problem through an education program designed to reduce the use of
- 9 tobacco products by young people.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.24 RCW
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (1) In addition to the taxes provided in RCW 82.24.020, there is
- 13 imposed and shall be collected, an additional tax upon the sale, use,
- 14 consumption, handling, possession, or distribution of cigarettes, in an
- 15 amount equal to the rate of two and one-half mills per cigarette.
- 16 (2) Revenues collected under this section shall be deposited in the
- 17 youth tobacco prevention account established in section 4 of this act.

- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 The department of health shall implement a program to discourage
- 4 young people from smoking. The program may include grants to public
- 5 schools.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 The youth tobacco prevention account is created in the state
- 9 treasury. All receipts from the tax in section 2 of this act must be
- 10 deposited into the account. Moneys in the account may be spent only
- 11 after appropriation. Expenditures from the account may be used only
- 12 for the purposes of section 3 of this act.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. This act takes effect October 1, 1997.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** If any provision of this act or its
- 15 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 16 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 17 persons or circumstances is not affected.
