- 1 AN ACT Relating to agency ratings for industrial insurance;
- 2 amending RCW 51.44.170; and amending 1990 c 204 s 1 (uncodified).
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 51.44.170 and 1991 sp.s. c 13 s 29 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 The industrial insurance premium refund account is created in the
- 7 state treasury. All industrial insurance refunds earned by state
- 8 agencies or institutions of higher education under the state fund
- 9 retrospective rating program shall be deposited into the account.
- 10 ((Moneys in the account may be spent only after appropriation.)) Only
- 11 moneys earned through the retrospective rating program are outside the
- 12 biennial expenditure limitation imposed on agencies by the legislature
- 13 and must be available for expenditure by agencies through an account
- 14 not subject to the appropriation process. No agency or institution of
- 15 higher education may ((receive an appropriation)) make requests for
- 16 expenditures for an amount greater than the refund earned by the
- 17 agency. An expenditure request must be detailed and filed with the
- 18 state treasurer. Expenditure requests must be subject to periodic
- 19 review by the office of financial management. Expenditures from the

- account shall be used to pay for any dedicated staff assigned to
 workers' compensation claims management and may be used for any program
 within an agency or institution of higher education((, but preference
 shall be given to programs)) that promotes or provides incentives for
 employee workplace safety and health and early, appropriate return-towork for injured employees.
- 7 Sec. 2. 1990 c 204 s 1 (uncodified) is amended to read as follows: 8 The legislature finds that workplace safety in state employment is 9 of paramount importance in maintaining a productive and committed state The legislature also finds that recognition in state 10 agencies and institutions of higher education of industrial insurance 11 programs that provide safe working environments and promote early 12 return-to-work for injured employees will encourage agencies and 13 14 institutions of higher education to develop these programs. A purpose 15 of this act is to provide incentives for agencies and institutions of 16 higher education to participate in industrial insurance safety programs and return-to-work programs by authorizing use of the industrial 17 18 insurance premium refunds earned by agencies or institutions of higher 19 education participating in industrial insurance retrospective rating programs. Since agency retrospective rating refunds are generated from 20 safety performance and cannot be set at predictable levels determined 21 by the budget process, the incentive awards should not impact, by a 22 23 like amount, an agency's legislatively approved budget.
