SENATE BILL 5981

- 1 AN ACT Relating to providing instruction in the language and
- 2 cultures of other nations; adding new sections to chapter 28A.180 RCW;
- 3 and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the significant
- 6 increase of trade and commerce and interaction between the United
- 7 States and other countries makes it imperative that action be taken to
- 8 ensure that Washington state increases the number of individuals who
- 9 are fluent in languages other than English and who understand the
- 10 culture and customs of other countries. These actions will help to
- 11 ensure that Washington state maintains its leading role in
- 12 international trade.
- 13 The legislature further finds one way to increase the development
- 14 of foreign languages and knowledge of foreign cultures is to ensure
- 15 that students who speak a language other than English at home do not
- 16 lose their ability to communicate in the language of their parents and
- 17 forbearers.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.180
- 2 RCW to read as follows:
- 3 In addition to the other requirements of this chapter, school
- 4 districts may provide world language instruction to students who come
- 5 from homes where the primary language is other than English. In
- 6 addition, school districts may provide instruction regarding the
- 7 culture of the country from which the students' families emigrated.
- 8 The purpose of the instruction is not to help the students understand
- 9 English better, but to improve the students' ability to speak their
- 10 native language and to understand the culture and customs of the
- 11 country in which their families lived.
- 12 School districts offering the instruction shall develop assessments
- 13 to determine if participating students are improving language
- 14 competency and cultural understanding.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.180
- 16 RCW to read as follows:
- 17 School districts shall encourage the active participation of
- 18 members from appropriate ethnic communities in establishing and
- 19 implementing the instructional program in section 2 of this act.
- 20 School districts are encouraged to appoint advisory councils to
- 21 participate in curriculum development and other decisions including the
- 22 selection of staff pertaining to the instructional program under
- 23 section 2 of this act. Members of the ethnic communities also should
- 24 be encouraged to participate financially in the program.
