- 1 AN ACT Relating to Seattle Reign license plates; amending RCW
- 2 46.16.301 and 46.16.313; adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW;
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW; adding a new section to
- 4 chapter 28A.150 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes that the
- 7 opportunities, and hence the participation level, of school-age girls
- 8 in athletics is less than that of boys. Further, the legislature
- 9 recognizes that the Seattle Reign, Washington state's first women's
- 10 professional basketball team, has just completed an inspiring inaugural
- 11 season. To aid the cause of girls in sports, the Seattle Reign license
- 12 plate is established.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 "Seattle Reign license plates" means license plates that display a
- 16 symbol of the Seattle Reign, the state's first professional women's
- 17 basketball team.

- 1 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.16.301 and 1995 3rd sp.s. c 1 s 102 are each 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (1) The department may create, design, and issue special license 4 plates that may be used in lieu of regular or personalized license 5 plates for motor vehicles required to display two motor vehicle license 6 plates, excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon 7 terms and conditions established by the department. The special plates 8 may:
 - (a) Denote the age or type of vehicle; or

- 10 (b) Denote special activities or interests; or
- 11 (c) Denote the status, or contribution or sacrifice for the United 12 States, the state of Washington, or the citizens of the state of 13 Washington, of a registered owner of that vehicle; ((or))
- (d) Display a depiction of the name and mascot or symbol of a state university, regional university, or state college as defined in RCW 28B.10.016; or
- 17 <u>(e) Display a symbol of the Seattle Reign, the state's first</u>
 18 professional women's basketball team.
- 19 (2) The department shall create, design, and issue a special baseball stadium license plate that may be used in lieu of regular or 20 personalized license plates for motor vehicles required to display two 21 motor vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles registered under 22 chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the 23 24 department. The special plates shall commemorate the construction of 25 a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485. The department shall 26 also issue to each recipient of a special baseball stadium license 27 plate a certificate of participation in the construction of the baseball stadium. 28
- 29 (3) The department has the sole discretion to determine whether or 30 not to create, design, or issue any series of special license plates, 31 other than the special baseball stadium license plate under subsection (2) of this section, and whether any interest or status merits the 32 issuance of a series of special license plates. 33 In making this determination, the department shall consider whether or not an interest 34 or status contributes or has contributed significantly to the public 35 health, safety, or welfare of the citizens of the United States or of 36 37 this state or to their significant benefit, or whether the interest or status is recognized by the United States, this state, or other states, 38 39 in other settings or contexts. The department may also consider the

- potential number of persons who may be eligible for the plates and the
- 2 cost and efficiency of producing limited numbers of the plates.
- design of a special license plate shall conform to all requirements for 3
- plates for the type of vehicle for which it is issued, as provided 4
- 5 elsewhere in this chapter.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 6
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Beginning January 1, 1998, the department shall issue license
- 9 plates depicting a symbol of the Seattle Reign.
- 10 RCW 46.16.313 and 1996 c 165 s 506 are each amended to Sec. 5. 11 read as follows:
- (1) The department may establish a fee for each type of special 12
- 13 license plates issued under RCW 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c) in an
- amount calculated to offset the cost of production of the special 14
- 15 license plates and the administration of this program. The fee shall
- not exceed thirty-five dollars and is in addition to all other fees 16
- 17 required to register and license the vehicle for which the plates have
- 18 been requested. All such additional special license plate fees
- collected by the department shall be deposited in the state treasury 19
- and credited to the motor vehicle fund. 20
- (2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 21
- 22 application, registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle,
- 23 the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay a fee of thirty
- 24 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two
- 25 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
- and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus 26
- 27
- the cost of plate production, shall be remitted to the custody of the
- 28 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report.
- 29 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license
- plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890. 30
- (3) Except as set forth under subsection (4) of this section, in 31
- 32 addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application,
- 33 registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle, the holder
- of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty 34
- 35 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two
- dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 36
- 37 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus

the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to a county for the 1 2 purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 3 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while 4 the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, 5 the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund. 6 7 (4) Until June 30, 1997, in addition to all fees and taxes required 8 to be paid upon application, registration, and renewal registration of 9 a motor vehicle, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate 10 shall pay a fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 11 subsection for license plate administration and collection expenses 12 incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed to a 13 county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on 14 15 bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined 16 in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction 17 costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state 18 19 general fund.

20 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application, registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle, 21 22 the holder of a Seattle Reign license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 23 24 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus 25 the cost of plate production, shall be remitted to the custody of the 26 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state 27 treasurer shall remit the proceeds to the superintendent of public 28 29 instruction for grants to fund girls' participation in school sports. 30 The superintendent shall make the proceeds available to girls in kindergarten through twelfth grade. The superintendent shall develop 31 rules to implement this grant program. 32

33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.150

34 RCW to read as follows:

A Seattle Reign license plate fund is established in the custody of the state treasurer for all receipts from Seattle Reign license plates.
