- 1 AN ACT Relating to an increase in the amount of motor vehicle
- 2 excise tax transmitted to the county public health account; and
- 3 reenacting and amending RCW 82.44.110.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.44.110 and 1995 1st sp.s. c 15 s 2 and 1995 c 398 6 s 14 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:
- 7 The county auditor shall regularly, when remitting license fee
- 8 receipts, pay over and account to the director of licensing for the
- 9 excise taxes collected under the provisions of this chapter. The
- 10 director shall forthwith transmit the excise taxes to the state
- 11 treasurer.
- 12 (1) The state treasurer shall deposit the excise taxes collected
- 13 under RCW 82.44.020(1) as follows:
- 14 (a) 1.60 percent into the motor vehicle fund to defray
- 15 administrative and other expenses incurred by the department in the
- 16 collection of the excise tax.
- 17 (b) 8.15 percent into the Puget Sound capital construction account
- 18 in the motor vehicle fund.

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- 1 (c) 4.07 percent into the Puget Sound ferry operations account in 2 the motor vehicle fund.
- 3 (d) 5.88 percent into the general fund to be distributed under RCW 4.82.44.155.
- 5 (e) 4.75 percent into the municipal sales and use tax equalization 6 account in the general fund created in RCW 82.14.210.
- 7 (f) 1.60 percent into the county sales and use tax equalization 8 account in the general fund created in RCW 82.14.200.
- 9 (g) ((62.6440 percent into the general fund through June 30, 1995, 10 and 57.6440)) 56.494 percent into the general fund ((beginning July 1, 1995)).
- 12 (h) 5 percent into the transportation fund created in RCW 82.44.180 13 beginning July 1, 1995.
- 14 (i) 5.9686 percent into the county criminal justice assistance 15 account created in RCW 82.14.310.
- 16 (j) 1.1937 percent into the municipal criminal justice assistance 17 account for distribution under RCW 82.14.320.
- 18 (k) 1.1937 percent into the municipal criminal justice assistance 19 account for distribution under RCW 82.14.330.
- 20 (1) ((2.95)) <u>4.1</u> percent into the county public health account 21 created in RCW 70.05.125.
- Notwithstanding (i) through (k) of this subsection, no more than sixty million dollars shall be deposited into the accounts specified in
- 24 (i) through (k) of this subsection for the period January 1, 1994,
- $25\,$ through June 30, 1995. Not more than five percent of the funds
- 26 deposited to these accounts shall be available for appropriations for
- 27 enhancements to the state patrol crime laboratory system and the
- 28 continuing costs related to these enhancements. Motor vehicle excise
- 29 tax funds appropriated for such enhancements shall not supplant
- 30 existing funds from the state general fund. For the fiscal year ending
- 31 June 30, 1998, and for each fiscal year thereafter, the amounts
- 32 deposited into the accounts specified in (i) through (k) of this 33 subsection shall not increase by more than the amounts deposited into
- 34 those accounts in the previous fiscal year increased by the implicit
- 35 price deflator for the previous fiscal year. Any revenues in excess of
- 36 this amount shall be deposited into the general fund.
- 37 (2) The state treasurer shall deposit the excise taxes collected 38 under RCW 82.44.020(2) into the transportation fund.

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1 (3) The state treasurer shall deposit the excise tax imposed by RCW 2 82.44.020(3) into the air pollution control account created by RCW 3 70.94.015.

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
