- 1 AN ACT Relating to moneys received by the state pursuant to
- 2 litigation or settlements with the tobacco industry; and adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 43.79 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.79 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The legislature recognizes that the sale of tobacco products in
- 8 the state has resulted in significant damage to the public health of
- 9 the state. In any legal action, or settlement thereof, by the state of
- 10 Washington against tobacco companies for damages for injuries to the
- 11 public health for violation of state and federal consumer protection
- 12 and antitrust laws and to recover moneys for tobacco-related health
- 13 care costs, and to the maximum extent permitted by court order,
- 14 negotiated settlement, or federal law, the proceeds received by the
- 15 state, exclusive of costs and fees, shall be subject to legislative
- 16 appropriation and shall be deposited in:
- 17 (a) The education enhancement account, which is created in the
- 18 state treasury. Moneys in the account may be spent only after
- 19 appropriation and may be used exclusively for enhancing and improving

- 1 the common school system of the state, including alcohol, tobacco, and
- 2 drug abuse awareness and prevention programs targeted at youths.
- 3 Moneys in the account shall not be used to (i) replace or supplant
- 4 existing state funding, (ii) meet the state's constitutional obligation
- 5 to provide for basic education programs under chapter 28A.150 RCW, or
- 6 (iii) increase the compensation and benefits of personnel in the common
- 7 schools; and
- 8 (b) The health services account established by RCW 43.72.900.
- 9 Moneys deposited in the health services account under this section may
- 10 be used exclusively for funding the enrollment of eligible persons in
- 11 the basic health plan under chapter 70.47 RCW, including funding a
- 12 smoking cessation benefit in the basic health plan.
- 13 (2) The proceeds identified in subsection (1) of this section shall
- 14 be divided equally between the two accounts specified in subsection (1)
- 15 of this section except (a) as otherwise required by federal law, or (b)
- 16 as the court determines essential to provide appropriate damages and
- 17 other relief to the parties to the litigation.
- 18 (3) In any legal action, or settlement thereof, by the state of
- 19 Washington to recover damages for health care costs and for other
- 20 tobacco-related injuries to the public health, including antitrust and
- 21 consumer protection violations, the attorney general shall seek a legal
- 22 resolution of the action that is consistent with and maximizes the
- 23 effect of this section.
- 24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its
- 25 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 26 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 27 persons or circumstances is not affected.
