- 1 AN ACT Relating to the endorsement of school sealant endorsed
- 2 dental hygienists; adding new sections to chapter 18.29 RCW; and
- 3 creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that access to
- 6 preventive and restorative oral health services by low-income children
- 7 is currently restricted by complex regulatory, financial, cultural, and
- 8 geographic barriers that have resulted in a large number of children
- 9 suffering unnecessarily from dental disease. The legislature also
- 10 finds that very early exposure to oral health care can reverse this
- 11 disease in many cases, thereby significantly reducing costs of
- 12 providing dental services to low-income populations.
- 13 It is the intent of the legislature to address the problem of poor
- 14 access to oral health care by providing for school-based sealant
- 15 programs through the certification of dental hygienists.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A dental hygienist licensed under this
- 17 chapter may apply for endorsement by the department of health as a

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- 1 school sealant endorsed dental hygienist upon completion of an approved
- 2 educational course developed by the secretary of health.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) For targeted populations and in coordination with local public health jurisdictions, dental hygienists
- 5 who are school sealant endorsed under section 2 of this act may assess
- 6 for and apply sealants in public and private schools.
- 7 (2) A dental hygienist endorsed under section 2 of this act shall
- 8 ensure that each patient for whom the dental hygienist applies sealants
- 9 has the opportunity to be examined by a dentist within twelve months
- 10 after the application of the sealant.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** (1) The school sealant endorsement program
- 12 will accept applications upon the establishment of the endorsement
- 13 course by the secretary, or by July 1, 1999, whichever is sooner.
- 14 (2) The department of health shall report to the legislature by
- 15 December 1, 2002, on the impact of granting school sealant endorsements
- 16 to dental hygienists to assess for and apply sealants in public and
- 17 private schools.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Sections 2 through 4 of this act are each
- 19 added to chapter 18.29 RCW.

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
