- AN ACT Relating to candidates' and voters' pamphlets; amending RCW
- 2 29.80.010; and adding a new section to chapter 29.81 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.80.010 and 1987 c 295 s 17 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The secretary of state shall publish a candidates' pamphlet as
- 7 soon as possible before each state general election at which <u>one or</u> 8 more federal or state officials are to be elected((, the secretary of
- 9 state shall publish and mail to each individual place of residence of
- 10 the state a candidates' pamphlet containing)) or at which a person is
- 11 to be elected to fill a vacancy in a federal or state office. In
- 12 addition, the secretary of state shall publish a candidates' pamphlet
- 13 for a primary held to nominate persons for a federal or state office or
- 14 to nominate persons to be elected to fill a vacancy in a federal or
- 15 state office, if sufficient time exists and sufficient money has been
- 16 <u>appropriated for this purpose</u>.
- 17 The secretary of state shall mail a candidates' pamphlet to each
- 18 individual place of residence in the state, if voters state-wide will

- 1 the secretary of state need only mail a candidates' pamphlet to each
- 2 <u>individual place of residence in the applicable congressional or</u>
