- 6 It shall be the duty of the school directors' association (1) to 7 take such action as the association deems advisable to effect a 8 coordination of policymaking, control, and management of the school districts of the state whose directors are members of the school 9 directors' association; and (2) to prepare and submit to the 10 superintendent of public instruction annually, and oftener if deemed 11 advisable by the association, reports and recommendations respecting 12 the aforesaid matters and any other matters which in the judgment of 13 14 the association pertain to an increase in the efficiency of the common 15 school system.
